For the kingdom of heaven is as a man traveling into a far country, —And unto one he gave five talents, to another two and to another one, to every man according to his several ability; —After a long time the Lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them. —For unto every one that hath shall be given, —but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath. And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness:—

Acts 16:31

Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, —justified by the faith of Christ,—

Gal. 2:16-17

By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith—[righteousness]

Rom. 1:5

—faith is counted for righteousness. —Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; —and calleth those things which be not as though they were.—

Rom. 4:3-25

—For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Rom. 10: 8-15

—as God is true, —all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, —for by faith ye stand.

2 Cor. 1:18-24

Holding the mystery of faith in a pure conscience. [righteous]

1 Tim. 3:9

—the life that I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God,—

Gal. 2:19-21

For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God, but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.

—but try the Spirits whether they be of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. —They are of the world:—and the world heareth them.—

—Take heed that no man deceive you. —many false prophets shall rise, —and because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom, shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

Matt. 24:4-14

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. —By faith Moses—choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasure of sin for a season; —he endured as seeing him who is invisible.—

Heb. 11:1-35

—Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.

2 Tim. 3:10-17

Be not deceived, God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Gal. 6:7-10

—that no man put a stumbling block or an occasion to fall in his brother's way. —offended, or is made weak. —For whatsoever is not of faith is sin. [unrighteousness]

Rom. 14:11-23

—For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.—

Romans 8

—And be not conformed to this world;—

Romans 12

—For sin shall not have dominion over you: —But God be thanked, —Being then made free from sin, —yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness: —and the end everlasting life.—

Romans 6

—My brethren, rejoice in the Lord —Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of concision, —I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: —that I may win Christ, —(For many walk, —enemies of the cross of Christ: Whose end is destruction whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.)

For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry,—

1 Sam. 15:23

Enter ye in at the strait gate; —which leadeth unto life. —A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, —Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; —depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Matt. 7:13-23

—for brethren ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, —walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. —Now the works of the flesh are manifested, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like— they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.—

Gal. 5:13-26

So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth, —as many as I love, I rebuke and chasten; be zealous therefore, and repent. —To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne,—

Rev. 3:16-22

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; —my son, dispise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him: For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth, If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; —But if ye be without chastisement, wherefore all are partakers, then are ye bastards and not Sons. —follow peace with all men, and holiness without which no man shall see the Lord: Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; —lest any root of bitterness —Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, —was rejected;—

Heb 12:1-17

continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

Acts 14:22

—For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight in glory;—the things which are not seen are eternal.

2 Cor. 4:1-18

Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, —For the time is come that judgement must begin at the house of God;—

1 Pet. 4:12-19

—that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

1 Cor. 2:1-5

—that the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, —Be ye holy; for I AM holy. —purify your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned LOVE —Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

1 Pet. 1:7-25

—work out you own salvation with fear and trembling.

Phili 2:12

—Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised:) And let us consider one another to provoke unto LOVE and to good works: —Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. —Now the just shall live by faith:—
