—false apostles, deceitful workers, —\*\*\*—shall come in my name, saying—and shall deceive many. —But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. —then shall appear the sign of the Son of man —coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. —two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. —be—ready:—\*\*\*—live unto righteousness:— 2 Cor. 11:13-15 \* Matthew, 24 \* 1 Peter 2:21-25

—manifested to take away our sins; —\*\*\*Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, —the bread of life: —we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, —\*\*\*—the word of God, which liveth and abideth forever.

—I am come that they might have life, —\*\*\*—the word—bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, —the grace of God in truth: \*\*\*—seek a proof of Christ, —Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves, —how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be rebobates?—

—delivered for our offences,—\*\*\*—Christ died for the ungodly. —abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ. —\*\*\*—the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

—redemption —\*\*\*—through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, —\*\*\*—grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ, —when he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.—

—Christ, who is our life, shall appear, —\*\*\*—which was, and is, and is to come. —\*\*\*—the resurrection, and the life:—Believest thou this? —Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God.—  
Col. 3:4 \* Revelation, 4 \* John 11:25-27

—Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, —And the devil—and the false prophets—shall be tormented day and night forever and ever. —the lake of fire. This is the second death. —\*\*\* Awake to righteousness, and sin not; —the knowledge of God: —a spiritual body. —Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,(not by men, neither, by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, —If any man preach any other gospel—let him be accursed. —

—even Christ pleased not himself: —\*\*\*—I do always those things that please the Father. —\*\*\*—the works which the Father hath given me to finish, —bear witness of me, —Search the scriptures;—  
Rom. 15:1-7 \* John 8:28-30 \* John 5:19-47

—the power of the Lord—present to heal—saying, Thy sins be forgiven thee; —Rise up and walk? —glorifying God. —\*\*\*—which had given such power unto men: \*\*\*—that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.  
Luke 5:17-26 \* Matt. 9:1-9 \* Acts 4:28-31

—mighty works—because of unbelief. \*\*\*—because they repented not: —thou—which art exalted unto heaven, shalt be brought down to hell: —\*\*\*If I do not the works of my Father believe me not. —believe the works: that ye know, and believe,—  
Matt 13-58 \* Matt. 11:20-24 \* John 10:37-38

—as thou hast believed, —\*\*\*—the childrens bread, —\*\*\*—thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.

—be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live —\*\*\*— that the works of God should be made manifest—\*\*\*—Lazarus was sick—Jesus—said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.

—Who is God—who is a rock save our God? —delivered—\*\*\*—delivered me. \*\*\*Many are the afflictions of the righteous; but the LORD delivereth him out of them all.

—Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above: \*\*\*—Job—was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil. —integrity—And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, —Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly. —LORD—no thought can be withholden from thee, —the LORD also accepted Job. And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, —\*\*\*Be patient—swear not — if any—err from the truth —convert him—save a soul from death,

—Give thanks unto the Lord, and call upon his name, —say ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, —and deliver us from the heathen, —\*\*\*— Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, —\*\*\*THE earth is the LORD's—

—if I be lifted up from the earth, I will draw all men unto me. \*\*\*—Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.\*\*\* —by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing—by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgement and predition of ungodly men. —the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works — the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; —grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

—unto salvation to every one that believeth; —therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: —the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, —For the invisible things —are clearly seen, being understood—so that they are without excuse: —vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart—dishonour their own bodies between themselves; —they which commit such things are worthy of death—\*\*\*—That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:— Rom. 1:16-32 \* Mark 7:1-23

—God hath said, ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. —\*\*\*Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body. —\*\*\*— gird up the loins of your mind.— Genesis, 3 \* Romans, 6 \* 1 Peter, 1

—live in the Spirit, —\*\*\*—do good and to communicate—\*\*\*Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. —go and bring forth fruit, —in my name, — Gal. 5:22-26 \* Heb. 13:15-21 \* John 15:1-16

—Learn not the way of the heathen, —Every man is brutish in his knowledge: —vanity, and the work of errors: —pastors are become brutish, —the way of man is not in himself: —\*\*\*but by every word—of God.\*\*\*He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my words, hath one that judgeth him: the word—shall judge him in the last day. Jeremiah, 10 \* Matt. 4:4 \* John 12:48

Every word of God is pure:\*\*\* —upon this rock I will build my church;—unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: —\*\*\*—keep thyself pure. Prov. 30:5-9 \* Matt. 16:13-19 \* 1 Tim. 5:22

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: —\*\*\*— be swift to hear—\*\*\*—Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God. —The seed is the word of God. Those by the way side—They on the rock—And that which fell among thorns are they, which, —bring no fruit to perfection. —hear the word of God, and do it. Hosea 4:6 \* James 1:19 \* Luke 8:4-21

—salt of the earth—light of the world—your righteousness—enter into the kingdom of heaven. —\*\*\*—be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. —No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; —Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things. —to the subverting of the hearers. —\*\*\*—and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgement thou shalt condemn. — Matthew, 5 \* 2 Tim. 2:1-16 \* Isaiah 54:14-17

—receive my words, —\*\*\*—Honour the LORD with thy substance, —\*\*\*—no vision, the people perish:— Proverbs, 2 \* Proverbs, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 \* Prov. 29:18

—the whole armour of God, —is the word of God: —\*\*\*—For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper —\*\*\*—as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: —cease from sin; —speak as the oracles of God; — Ephesians, 6 \* Hebrews, 4 \* 1 Peter, 4

—be full of the knowledge of the LORD, —call upon his name, —\*\*\*— —that hath called us to glory and virtue: —Add to your faith virtue; -to \* knowledge; -to \* temperance; -to \* patience; -to \* godliness; -to \* brotherly kindness; -to \* charity. —he that lacketh these things is blind, —if ye do these things, ye shall never fall: —\*\*\*— Please God— Isaiah, 11, 12 \* 2 Peter, 1 \* Hebrews, 11

—meditate therein day and night —possess the land. \*\*\*—supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; —come unto the knowledge of the truth. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus: —\*\*\*—will forgive their sins, and will heal their land.— Joshua 1:8-11 \* 1 Tim. 2:1-6 \* 2 Chor. 7:14-16

—return unto the Lord, —bread to the eater: —\*\*\*—knowledge—the power that worketh in us, —\*\*\*—whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and —shall believe— shall have whatsoever he saith.— Isaiah 55:7-13 \* Eph. 3:13-21 \* Mark 11:22-26

—LORD, what is man, that thou takest knowledge of him! —Man is like to vanity: —falsehood—\*\*\*—\*\*\*—man is born unto trouble,— Psalms, 144 \* Psalms, 8 \* Job, 5:7-11

—should not lust after evil things, —\*\*\*FROM whence come wars and fightings—your lusts that war in your members—Ye adulterers and adulteresses, —what is your life? —\*\*\* what shall it profit a man, if he—loose his own soul? 1 Corinthians, 10 \* James, 4 \* Mark 8:34-38

—Beware ye of the leaven of —hypocrisy. —of covetousness; for mans life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth. —that servant, which knew his lord's will, and prepared not himself, neither did according to his will shall be beaten with many stripes, —\*\*\*—that evil servant shall say in his heart, —The Lord of that servant shall come —And shall cut him asunder and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites; — Luke, 12 \* Matthew, 24

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, —\*\*\*—go on unto perfection; —it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, —If they fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; —that which beareth thorns and briars is rejected, —whose end is to be burned. Hebrew 10:26-31 \* Hebrew 6:1-8

And in hell he lifted up his eyes, being in torment. —\*\*\*where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched, —\*\*\*—except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. —bear fruit— Luke 16:23 \* Mark 9:44-50 \* Luke 13:3-9

—This man receiveth sinners, —\*\*\*The Son of man—Come unto ME, —\*\*\*—hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, — Luke, 15 \* Matt. 11:15-30 \* Rev. 3:20-22

—be not soon shaken—the day of Christ is at hand. —For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: —in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth. —\*\*\*For such are false apostles, deceitful workers,

transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. —Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. —his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; —\*\*\*—who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord—And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you:—selfwilled, —Spots they are and blimishes, sporting themselves with their own deceivings—Having eyes full of adultery, beguiling unstable souls; an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; —wells without water, —While they promise—liberty they themselves are the servants of corruption:—

2 Thessalonians, 2 \* 2 Cor. 11:13-15 \* 2 Peter, 2

—Get thee behind me Satan; thou art an offence unto me; for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men. \*\*\*—ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: —ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves. —ye blind guides, —\*\*\*—Except ye be converted, —woe unto the world because of offences! for it needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!

Matt. 16:23 \* Matthew, 23 \* Matt. 18:3-7

—God is light, —truth: —\*\*\*he that hateth his brother is in darkness, —because that darkness hath blinded his eyes—\*\*\*—He that hateth me hateth my Father also.

1 John, 1 \* 1 John 2,3 \* John 15:18-23

—the devil, —is a liar, and the Father of it. —\*\*\*The spirit of man is the candle of the LORD searching all the inward parts of the belly. \*\*\*—every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof —by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

John 8:40-51 \* Prov. 20:27 \* Matt. 12:30-37

—the judgement of God is according to truth—Who will render to every man according to his deeds:—\*\*\*—the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity:—it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell. —\*\*\*—speak every man truth—Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, —

Rom. 2:1-11 \* James, 3 \* Eph. 4:25-29

A naughty person, —\*\*\*—A wicked doer—\*\*\*—shall fall by his own wickedness. —transgressors shall be taken in their own naughtiness. —

Prov. 6:12-35 \* Prov. 17:4-28 \* Proverbs, 11

—purpose. \*\*\*—to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, —whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness—\*\*\*BE ye therefore followers of God—as Christ—neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting —know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.—

Rom. 8:27-28 \* Romans, 6 \* Eph. 5:1-6

—Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, —deliver thyself, —keep thy Fathers commandment, —when thou goest, it shall lead thee; when thou sleepest, it shall keep thee; when thou awakest, it shall talk with thee. —\*\*\*—It is good for a man not to touch a woman. —if they cannot contain, let them marry; for it is better to marry than to burn.

Proverbs, 6 \* 1 Corinthians, 7

—Give not thy strength unto women, —who can find a virtuous woman? —\*\*\*— in the fear of God. Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. —\*\*\*—LIKEWISE, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, —that your prayers be not hindered. —not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing.—

Proverbs, 31 \* Eph. 5:21-33 \* 1 Peter, 3

—do all things through Christ which strengtheneth —\*\*\*—even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. —\*\*\*Take heed to yourself: —forgive—

Phil. 4:3-13 \* Colossians, 3 \* Luke 17:1-4

—keep his testimonies, —with the whole heart. —do no iniquities: —\*\*\*—in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour and some to dishonour. —\*\*\*—restore such —spirit of meekness—

Psalms 119:2-3 \* 2 Tim. 2:19-26 \* Gal. 6:1-10

—iniquity was not found in his lips; he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity. —\*\*\*—in wisdom and in knowledge, and in equity; —\*\*\*THE LORD reigneth; —equity,—

Malachi 2:6-7 \* Eccle. 2:20-26 \* Psalms, 99

—my word like as a fire — like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces \*\*\*—greater is he that is in you, —\*\*\*—to help us, and to fight our battles.—

Jere. 23:29 \* 1 Jn. 4:4 \* 2 Chron. 32:8

—the LORD is a man of war:—dashed in pieces the enemy,\*\*\*—ye sorrowed to repentance: for ye were made sorry after a godly manner,—For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation—\*\*\*—serve the living and true God; —even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.

Exodus, 15 \* 2 Corinthians, 7 \* 1 Thes. 1:5-10
