— Jesus saith — I ascend unto my Father, and your Father, and to my God, and to your God,
—Peace be unto you; as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you,—HE BREATHED on
them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost: John 20:11-31

But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of
truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me: John 15:26

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all
things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I HAVE SAID unto you. John 14:26

— To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to
God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, and to Jesus the mediator of
the new covenant and to the blood of sprinkling, —See that ye refuse not him that speaketh.
For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape,
if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven;— Heb. 12:22-29

— Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which
is born of flesh is flesh and that which is born of Spirit is Spirit. Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must
be born again. —So is every one that is born of the Spirit. —For God so loved the world, that he gave his
only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. He that
believeth on him is not condemned; but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not
believed in the NAME of the only begotten Son of God.— John 3:1-21

— consider—Christ Jesus;—wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his
voice, — Take heed, brethern, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in departing
from the living God. —lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. — harden
not your heart,— Hebrews 3

— if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth.
This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. —confusion and
every evil work. James 3:14-18

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lust shall
they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; 2 Tim. 4:3-4

For they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God. John 12:42-43

— Hear and understand; — if the blind lead the blind both shall fall into the ditch.
Matt. 15:10-20

Therefore let no man glory in men.— 1 Cor. 3:18-23

—every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. Then when lust
hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.
James, 1

—if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
1 Jn. 2:1-6

Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith,
giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having
their conscience seared with a hot iron; —Neglect not the gift that is in thee, —Take heed unto
thyself, — save thyself and them that hear thee,— 1 Timothy, 4

—Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, To execute judgement upon all,
—ungodly —murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh
great swelling words, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage. —who—
walk after their own ungodly lusts. These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having
not the Spirit. But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the
Holy Ghost. Keep yourselves in the love of God, —And of some have compassion, making a
difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire: hating even the garment
spotted by the flesh. Jude 14-23

—I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have
preached to others, I myself should be a castaway. 1 Cor. 9:24-27

And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost — was led by the Spirit — Luke 4:1-20

—ye have an unction from the Holy One, —the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, — the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, — every one that doeth righteousness is born of him. 1 Jn. 2:20-29

—Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit,— Eph. 6:9-20

—the Spirit of truth, — will guide you into all truth, for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak; and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: — whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. —ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.—For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came OUT from God.—that in me ye might have peace.— I have overcome the world. John 16:13-33

—this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? — This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ;— 1 Jn. 5:1-6

— Rejoice in the Lord always:—Let your moderation be known unto all men. —in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your request be made known unto God. And the peace of God, — shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Philii. 4:4-20

— walk worthy — with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body, and one Spirit, — one Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God, and Father of all, — For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry,—Till we all come in unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, —fulness of Christ. Eph. 4:1-13

— For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell; And having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself;— Col. 1:16-29

— to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, — the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you: — and that there be no divisions among you, —Is Christ divided? 1 Corinthians, 1

— the chastisement of our peace was upon him;— Isaiah, 53

— For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; — So making peace; and that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby; — For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father. Eph. 2:13-22

— seek ye the kingdom of God: and all things shall be added unto you. Luke 12:23-40

— For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.— Romans, 14

— let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful. Colossians, 3

Be ye therefore followers of God as dear children; And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, —walk as children of light: (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;) —Awake thou that sleepest, — and Christ shall give thee light. — understanding what the will of the Lord is, — be filled with the Spirit; —Giving thanks always— Ephesians, 5

—prepare to meet thy God, — For, lo, he that formeth the mountains, and createth the winds, —The Lord, The God of hosts, is his name. Amos 4:12-13

And the Lord said, MY Spirit shall not always strive with man,— Gen. 6:3-13

Quench not the Spirit. 1 Thes. 5:19

—as the body without the Spirit is dead— James 2:26

Seek ye the Lord while he may be found, — for he will abundantly pardon,— Isaiah, 55:6-13

Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, and eat: yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. —Incline thine ear, and come unto ME: hear, and your soul shall live:— Isaiah, 55:1-5

—whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: —This is the covenant —saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them. Heb. 10:12-16

— with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart.
2 Cor. 3:3-6

— A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you, and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put MY Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgements, and do them,—
Eze. 36:26-27

— our heart burn within us, — while he opened to us the scriptures. Luke 24:32

And wine that maketh glad the heart of man, and oil to make his face to shine, and bread which strengtheneth man's heart. Ps. 104:15

THE LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. — He restoreth my soul:—I will fear no evil:— thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.— Psalms, 23

—though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day.
2 Cor.4:16

—For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive. —the last Adam was made a quickening spirit. —we shall all be changed, — O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?— 1 Cor. 15:10-58

—saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh; — before that great and notable day of the Lord come: And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. Acts 2:17-21

—through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: 1 Pet. 1:2-9

— whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life. —Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not,— John 4:13-15

— Received ye the Spirit by — the hearing of faith— Galatians, 3

—Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; —through Jesus Christ our savior; that being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. —that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works, — learn to maintain good works for necessary uses, —be not unfruitful.— Titus, 3

— be led of the Spirit, — inherit the kingdom of God, —the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance:— Gal. 5:18-26

— And the Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;— Isaiah, 11:2

— which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. Rev. 5:6

Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethern, I would not have you ignorant, —understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost. Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit. To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of the healing by the same Spirit; To another the working of miracles, to another Prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interperation of tongues: But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. —and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.— 1 Cor. 12:1-14

— for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. — Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth: comparing spiritual things with spiritual. —We have the mind of Christ. 1 Cor. 2:9-16

— to be spiritual minded is life and peace. — the Spirit is life because of righteousness. — For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. — the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain — we ourselves groan within ourselves, — For we are saved by hope: — with patience wait for it. Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. — If God be for us, who can be against us? — in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. — Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8

— They that were foolish — took no oil — But the wise took oil in their vessels” Matt. 25:1-13

— every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour; 1 Thes. 4:3-4

And Moses took the anointing oil, and anointed the tabernacle and all that was therein, and sanctified them.— Lev. 8:10-12

Now he which stablisheth us — in Christ, and hath anointed us, is God; Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts. 2 Cor. 1:21-22

— our earthly house of this tabernacle — a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. For in this we groan, — the earnest of the Spirit. — Wherefore our labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him. 2 Cor. 5:1-11

— he groaned in the spirit, — Jesus therefore again groaning in himself — John 11:33-38

— I have seen the affliction of my people — and I have heard their groanings, and am come down to deliver them.— Acts 7:34

For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need. Heb. 4:15-16

— that the works of God should be made manifest — I must work the works of him that sent me — John 9:3-4

I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught ME, I speak these things.— John 8:28-29

— The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do:— John 5:19-47

And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick. Matt. 14:14

— being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man. Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other. Mark 3:5

— Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Acts 2:38-39

— No man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish, But new wine must be put into new bottles; and both are preserved.— Luke 5:36-39

— Simon himself believed also, and when he was baptized, — wondered — offered them money, But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money. — for thy heart is not right in the sight of God. Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee. For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity. Acts 8:9-24

The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways:— Prov. 14:14

— empty — and the last state of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation. Matt. 12:43-45

— they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.— 2 Pet. 2:9-22

Turn, O backsliding children, saith the LORD: for I am married unto you:— Jere. 3:14

Return ye backsliding children, and I will heal your backslidings. Jer. 3:22

— if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men. And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come. Matt. 12:28-37

— he that blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation. Mark 3: 28-29

— If any man defile the temple of God, him God shall destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are,— 1 Cor. 3:10-23

— There is a sin unto death: —we know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not,— 1 Jn. 5:16-21

For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.— 1 Thes. 4:7-8

The Lord is my strength and my shield; — he is the saving strength of his anointed. Ps. 28:7-9

— Prepare ye the way of the Lord — preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. — he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost. — Jesus —straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove, descending upon him: Mark 1:3-11

And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; — If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him? Luke 11:9-13

— He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:— Matt. 3:11-12

For our God is a consuming fire. Heb. 12:29

The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth:— John 3:8

— And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting, And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost,— Acts 2:1-4

—fervent in Spirit; serving the Lord;— Romans, 12

For to do whatsoever thy hand and thy counsel determined before to be done. And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.— Acts 4:28-31

— ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto ME— Acts 1:8

— wise men, — fell down, and worshipped him: Matt. 2:1-11

— as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. Joshua 24:14-16

— And Joshua — was full of the Spirit of wisdom;— Deut. 34:7-9

— follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.— 2 Timothy, 2

— for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth, — Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; — he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal:that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together. John 4:23-36

— O ye simple, understand wisdom: — Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of MY lips shall be right things. For MY mouth shall speak truth; — All the words of MY mouth are in righteousness; — Receive MY Instructions,— Proverbs, 8

— Give unto the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness. Ps. 29:1-2

— whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning — But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quite spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.— 1 Pet. 3:1-18

The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. James 3:17

— Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. — Let no man bequile you —vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, — after the commandments and doctrines of men? Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body;— Col. 2:6-23

— people honoureth me with their lips, but their hearts is far from me. Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men. For laying aside the commandments of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups; and many other such like things ye do. — Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition,— Mark 7:2-23

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. Col. 3:16

Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs: singing and making melody in your hearts to the Lord; Eph. 5:19

—And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; —Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. — and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever. Revelation, 5

To the only wise God and Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. A-men. Jude 25

O'God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee; my soul thirsteth for thee, —Thus will I bless thee while I live: I will lift up my hands in thy NAME.— Ps. 63

— Saying I will declare thy NAME unto my brethren, in the mist of the church will I sing praise unto thee. Heb 2:9-12

Rejoice in the LORD, O ye righteous; for praise is comely for the upright. Praise the LORD with harp: —Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise. —Behold the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;— Ps. 33:1-22

—Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his NAME.— Psalms, 100

By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to his NAME.— Heb. 13:15-16

Thy righteousness is like the great mountains; thy judgements are a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast. Ps. 36:6

PRAISE ye the Lord. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power. Praise him for his mighty acts; praise him according to his excellent greatness. —Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD. Psalms, 150

O love the LORD, all ye HIS saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer. Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your hearts, all ye that hope in THE LORD. Ps. 31:23-24

Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed. Delight thyself also in the LORD: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart. Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass. And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgement as the noonday, Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him:— Ps. 37:3-7
